Welcome to CHaD

At CHaD, "patient and family-centered" care is important to us. This means that as a caregiver, you know your child best. That is why we consider you part of the "care team" and encourage you to partner with us in the care of your child.

What to Expect while your Child is in the Hospital

Visitors

CHaD's current visitor policy allows two adult caregivers on our inpatient unit at a time.

Check in Process

Each day, please check in at front desk where you will be given a daily visitor sticker.

Staying Overnight with your Child

One adult caregiver is encouraged to stay with their child overnight. There is a sleeper chair in each room and our staff can provide pillows and blankets.

Medical Rounds

Once a day, your child's medical team will visit your room to examine your child and discuss their treatment plan. Please ask questions and let them know if you have concerns. If you'd like to talk away from your child, you may ask the team to step outside of the room.

Call Bell

You will find the "Call Bell" either on the patient's remote or on the bed rail. Please use this to call staff about immediate patient needs.

Room Phone

The phone in your child's room is for you to use as needed.

Playroom

At CHaD, we encourage play! Our playroom has toys, art supplies, books, and games for all ages. Please ask a staff member about visiting the playroom, or having someone bring items to your child. We also have DVDs and video game systems for use in your child's room. *Please note that in-person visits to the playroom are currently limited.*

How do I connect to the internet?

Go to your WiFi settings and select "D-H Guest." You will be directed to a web page where you will need to agree to our terms of use.

Can I use the shower in my child's room?

Yes! Please use the bathroom/shower as your own. Our staff can provide towels.

Where can I charge my phone?

You can ask your nurse to charge it for you and they will return it when complete.

If I need to leave, how do I get updates about my child?

If you need to step away, please let your nurse know. You can call the Pedi Unit (603-650-7272) at any time for updates. You can also ask that someone from the team call you when there is something to share.
